INCLUDED ACTIVITIES

Breakfast Camp

It is only a quick ride up the mountain to a full pancake, egg, and bacon breakfast. Riders must be 6 years of age or older.

Steak fry Horseback Ride

A walking ride to and from our Steak-fry dinner.

Advanced Riding Program

New for 2024, the advanced riding program is headquartered in at the South Corral in the Elk Farm and offers quicker access to the less explored parts of the property. Riders can expect two and a half to three hours ride times, and the opportunity to learn advanced horseman ship skills as well as work cattle from horseback. This is for advanced riders. To participate in this program your riding skill will be accessed by wrangler.

Advanced Trail Ride

This ride leaves from the South Corral in Elk Farm and offers riders quicker access to the less explored parts of the property. Riders can expect more challenging terrain and two and half to three hours ride times. This is for advanced riders. To participate in this program your riding skill will be accessed by wrangler.

Walking Trail Ride

Our walking trail ride is designed for those who enjoy walking speed and walking speed only. This ride accommodates riders with basic skill levels and riders can expect an hour and half ride time. These rides will go up and down hills, cross small streams, and meander through the brush.

Walking Adult Extended Trail Ride

Identical to the walking ride but a ride time of two to two and a half hours. This ride will cover more terrain than the regular walking ride such as two track roads and occasionally blazing a new trail.

Intermediate Trail Ride

For riders looking to go faster than walking, the intermediate ride offers trotting and limited loping. This ride is designed for riders that want a little more than a basic trial ride and can be expected to last an hour to an hour and a half. The riding terrain will vary between hills and two track roads.

Intermediate Adult Extended Trail Ride

Identical to the intermediate ride but a ride time of two to two and a half hours. This ride also will cover varying terrain and reach further portions of the property.
